Of Mice and Men, published in 1937, and The Grapes of Wrath, published in 1939, were arguably Steinbeck's most famous and controversial novels. Of Mice and Men was originally conceived as a play, and after Steinbeck re-wrote the novelette for the stage, it received the Drama Critics Circle Award in 1937, and was nominated for a Pulitzer Prize.
